

# Man pleads guilty to possessing meth, fined RM2,900

**KUCHING:** A 39-year-old man was fined RM2,900 in default seven-month imprisonment after pleading guilty at the Magistrates' Court here yesterday to a charge of possessing methamphetamine.

Mohamad Saifullah Aduka entered the plea after the charge under Section 12(2) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952, punishable under Section 12(3) of the same Act, was read to him before Magistrate Ling Hui

Chuan.

The Section provides for a fine not exceeding RM100,000 or a jail term of up to five years, or both, upon conviction.

He committed the offence at a house in Taman Mesra Muara Tebas RMR at about 11.35pm on Jan 29, 2026.

According to the facts of the case, police raided the house and conducted a physical search on the accused, during which

they found a plastic packet in a black pouch bag containing crystalline lumps suspected to be methamphetamine.

A chemist report confirmed the substance to be methamphetamine weighing 0.05 grammes.

The case was prosecuted by deputy public prosecutor Ahmad Fauzulutfi Suriani, while the accused did not have legal representation.
