

Jobless man jailed 4 months for abusing amphetamine, meth

MIRI: An unemployed man was sentenced to four months in prison after pleading guilty at the Magistrates' Court here yesterday to a charge of abusing drugs.

Edmund Achin, 22, was also ordered by Magistrate Ashok Linggam to be placed under two years of police supervision upon the completion of his custodial sentence.

Edmund, from Quadruplex Bandar Baru Permyjaya here, was charged under Section 15(1)(a) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952, punishable under Section 15(1) of the same Act, which provides for a fine not exceeding RM5,000 or imprisonment for up to two years, upon conviction.

According to the charge, he was tested positive for amphetamine and methamphetamine at the Miri Narcotics Criminal Investigation Division office at about 11am on Dec 8, 2025.

Deputy public prosecutor Mohammad Syafiq Samry prosecuted, while Edmund was unrepresented by counsel.
