

Man pleads guilty to injuring co-worker, jailed five months

KUCHING: The Magistrates' Court here yesterday sentenced a security company worker to five months' jail and fined him RM1,000 in default one month in prison for injuring his colleague during an assault.

Magistrate Nursyaheeqa Nazwa Radzali convicted Thompson Dunssy, 44, on his guilty plea to a charge of causing grievous hurt under Section 325 of the Penal Code. The Section provides for up to seven years' imprisonment and a fine, upon conviction.

The offence was committed at the security company's office along Jalan Ensing Timur at

about 9.30am on Aug 26, 2026.

According to the facts of the case, Thompson punched his 23-year-old co-worker for using the company's stamp without seeking his permission.

The assault resulted in the victim suffering a fracture to his left ring finger.

During proceedings, the court heard that the accused committed the act because the victim had allegedly responded to him harshly.

Insp Siti Radhiah Abdul Rahman appeared for the prosecution, while the accused was unrepresented.
