

Man placed on good-behaviour bond over fake police report to escape fine for lost MyKad

KUCHING: A man who filed a false police report to avoid paying a fine for losing his identity card was yesterday placed on a six-month bond of good behaviour by the Magistrates' Court here.

Muhammad Zulfarissi Abdullah, 22, nodded in understanding as Magistrate

Ling Hui Chuan issued the order for the RM2,000 bond with one surety, under Section 67 of the Criminal Procedure Code.

According to the facts of the case, the accused lodged a report at the Padungan police station claiming that two men on a motorcycle had robbed him behind a building in the city at

around 7.50pm on March 20, 2025.

He reported the loss of his wallet which contained personal documents.

However, an investigation determined no such robbery had occurred and that the police report filed by the accused was false.

Further investigation revealed that Muhammad Zulfarissi had concocted the story to avoid paying a fine imposed by the National Registration Department for obtaining a new identity card.

Insp Nur Shafiq Nyaie Ilin handled the prosecution, while the accused was unrepresented.
