

Man fined RM3,000 for breaking windscreen of ex-colleague's pickup truck during argument

SIBU: The Magistrates' Court here yesterday fined a man RM3,000 in default 12 months' imprisonment for breaking the windscreen of a former colleague's vehicle.

Magistrate Oon Kork Chern convicted Ling Ing Hui, 50, on his own guilty plea to a charge under Section 425 of the

Penal Code, punishable under Section 427 of the same Act.

The offence was committed at a house in Lorong Wong King Huo 13 here at about 11.35am of Feb 21, 2026.

Ling paid the fine.

Based on the facts of the case, the 55-year-old complainant

went to the house to collect his pickup truck from the accused.

Upon arrival, a verbal argument ensued between them, with Ling then hurling a rock in the complainant's direction.

The rock struck the vehicle's rear windscreen, causing it to shatter.

During the incident, one of Ling's friends, whom the complainant did not know, also punched the complainant in the face.

The case was prosecuted by deputy public prosecutor Keshava Rao Tharma Raja, while Ling did not have legal representation.
