

Civil servant fined RM5,000 for abusing drugs

KUCHING: A civil servant was fined RM5,000 in default 11 months' imprisonment after he was found guilty of abusing drugs six years ago.

Magistrate Ling Hui Chuan imposed the sentence on Ramzi Rajak, 45, after ruling that the prosecution had proven its case beyond a reasonable doubt.

The accused was also ordered to undergo police supervision

for two years at the Tabuan Jaya police station in accordance with Section 38B of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952.

According to the charge, Ramzi was tested positive for amphetamine and methamphetamine at the Padawan Narcotics Criminal Investigation Division office at about 11pm on June 2, 2020.

He was charged under Section

15(1)(a) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952, punishable under Section 15(1) of the same Act, which provides for a fine not exceeding RM5,000 or up to two years' jail, upon conviction.

Deputy public prosecutors Adriana Maisarah Mohd Farid Ahmad Fauzulutfi Suriani prosecuted, while the accused was represented by counsel Abdul Rahman Mohamad Hazmi.
