

Man who uploaded obscene content of wife fined RM4,000

KUCHING: A mechanic was fined RM4,000 in default seven months in prison by the Magistrates' Court here yesterday for having pornographic videos on his mobile phone, and for uploading obscene content of his Indonesian wife on Facebook.

Bong Khee Jung, 48, pleaded guilty before Magistrate Ling Hui Chuan after the charge under Section 292 of the Penal Code was read to him.

The Section provides for up to three years in jail or a fine, or both, upon conviction.

The offences were committed at a house in a village along Jalan Kuching-Serian at around 3.25pm on May 16, 2024.

According to the facts of the case, Bong's 41-year-old wife was told by a friend that he had uploaded a video and photo of her on Facebook in April and May, respectively.

The video was of her undressing in the bathroom, while the photo showed her half-undressed as she was about to bathe.

Feeling humiliated and traumatised by her husband's action, and suspecting he had more of such content of her on

his mobile phone, the woman lodged a police report on May 16.

Following Bong's arrest, police inspected his mobile phone and discovered the offending material stored in the device.

Prior to sentencing, Bong told the court that he recorded and kept the video of his wife as 'security' so that his wife would not cheat on him.

Responding, the magistrate told him that any marital problems should be resolved amicably and not by resorting to such extreme measures.

Prosecuting the case was Insp Nur Shafiq Nyaie Ilin, while Bong was not represented.
