3 habitual addicts get jail, rotan

KOTA KINABALU: Three men were jailed five years plus a stroke of the cane each for taking syabu. Herrywan Jusit, 42, Awangku Pg Damit Pg Momin, 48, and Hisyamamiruddin Zulkepli, 33, pleaded guilty separately before Sessions Court Judge Elsie Primus, Monday. Herrywan was arrested on Aug 23, last year, while Awangku and Hisyamamiruddin were arrested on Sept 10 and 9, last year after they were tested positive at the Beaufort police station. They have several conviction records for taking drugs.
