

# Indonesian jailed five months for abusing meth, ordered deported

**MIRI:** The Magistrates' Court here yesterday sentenced an Indonesian woman to five months' jail for abusing methamphetamine last year.

Magistrate Ashok Linggam convicted Nafa, 29, from Singkawang on her own guilty plea to a charge under Section 15(1)(a) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952.

The court ordered her custodial sentence to begin from the date of her arrest on Dec 30 and for her to be referred to the Immigration Department for deportation upon her release from prison. The accused committed the offence at a premises along Jalan Miri-Bypass, Pujut Padang Kerbau here at 8.45am on Dec 30, 2025.

Insp Mudzilawati Abdul Rahman handled the prosecution, while the accused did not have legal representation.

In the same courtroom, Magistrate Ashok imposed a fine of RM2,500 in default three weeks' imprisonment on a 32-year-old woman for gambling online in a public place. Oliveana Sena Adon from Pujut 4 pleaded guilty after the charge under Section 7(2) of the Common Gaming Houses Act 1952 was read to her.

The facts of the case stated that the accused was arrested during a police raid at a convenience store in Pelita Commercial Centre here at about 2.50pm on May 19, 2026 after her mobile phone was found to contain an online gambling application. Oliveana, unrepresented, pleaded to the court for a lighter sentence on the grounds that this was her first offence.

The prosecution was conducted by deputy public prosecutor Mohammad Syafiq Samry.
