Man jailed 8 months, fined RM3,000 over child porn stash

KUCHING: A 41-year-old man was sentenced to eight months' jail after pleading guilty at the Magistrates' Court here yesterday to possessing 388 child pornography images in his desktop computer.

Magistrate Nursyaheeqa Nazwa Radzali also imposed a fine of RM3,000 in default three months' imprisonment on Chan Khin See, and ordered him to report to a police station for 12 months upon his release from prison.

Chan was charged under Section 10 of the Sexual Offences Against Children Act 2017, which provides for up to five years in prison or a fine not exceeding RM10,000, or both, on conviction.

He committed the offence at a house in Taman Malihah, Jalan Matang here at about 12.30pm on

Sept 15, 2026.

According to the facts of the case, police raided the house after receiving information from a Bukit Aman intelligence unit and conducted an inspection on the accused.

The inspection found that a custom-built desktop computer handed over by the accused contained 388 child pornography images.

It was established that the computer belonged to Chan and was under his control.

Apart from the computer, police also seized other devices, including a mouse, keyboard, drawing tablet, router and modem as evidence.

Prosecuting was Insp Siti Radhiah Abdul Rahman, while the accused was unrepresented by counsel.
