Sept 30 this year. He then examined the memory

card of the camera, which indicated that it could belong to Toh.

A police report was filed, and Toh was arrested the following day (Oct 1).

Investigations revealed that

Toh had indeed placed a camera

in the ceiling of the restroom of the company. The video content on camera's memory card

showed Toh's face and his action of installing the camera in the ceiling of the restroom. Insp Nur Shafiga Nyaie Ilin

prosecuted the case, while Toh was represented by Chan Khoon Moh.
