

# Youth fined RM900 for twice riding motorcycle without licence plate

**MIRI:** A youth was fined a total of RM900 in default eight days' jail after pleading guilty at the Magistrates' Court here yesterday to two charges of riding a motorcycle without a licence plate.

Willson Kiew Zhi Sheng, 20, from Tudan Phase 1 here entered the pleas after the charges under Section 14(1) of the Road Transport Act 1987, punishable under Section 14(4) of the same Act, were read to him before Magistrate Ashok Linggam.

The Section provides for a fine of between RM300 and RM3,000, upon conviction.

The court imposed a fine of RM450 in default four days' jail for each charge.

On the first charge, Kiew was charged with riding a motorcycle without a front licence plate along Jalan Malva here at 5.48pm on Feb 8, 2025.

On the second charge, he was charged with committing the same offence along Jalan Piasau here at 4.41pm on Feb 15, 2025.

The prosecution was conducted by deputy public prosecutor Mohammad Syafiq Samry, while the accused was unrepresented by counsel.
