

Woman, three others fined RM1,500 for trespassing into house compound

MIRI: Three men and a woman were each fined RM1,500 in default two weeks' jail after pleading guilty at the Magistrates' Court here yesterday to trespassing into the compound of a house owned by a senior citizen.

Cheng Siu Kang, 23, Lo Wei Kiong, 21, Daniel Boon Wui Hiong, 28, and Chai Xin Ping, 23, entered their plea before Magistrate Ashok Linggam to a charge under Section 447 of the Penal Code read together

with Section 34 of the same Code. The Section provides for up to six months' imprisonment or a fine not exceeding RM3,000, or both, upon conviction.

According to the facts of the case, all four accused unlawfully entered the compound of a house at a lot in Taman Senadin, Jalan Lutong-Kuala Baram here at about 10.08pm on March 10 this year. Deputy public prosecutor Mohammad Syafiq Samry handled the case, while the

accused were unrepresented.

In a separate case in the same courtroom, a man was sentenced to six months in prison for possessing methamphetamine.

Magistrate Ashok convicted Mohd Idzuan Abdullah @ Rex Tan, 51, from Kampung Senadin, Lutong here on his own guilty plea to a charge under Section 12(2) of the Dangerous Drugs Act 1952, punishable under Section 12(3) of the same Act.

The custodial sentence was ordered to run from the date of arrest on Jan 6 this year.

The facts of the case stated that Mohd Idzuan was detained in front of a premises at Lorong Mulia 2A, Lutong here at about 4.30pm on Jan 6 after he was found with 0.57 grammes of methamphetamine in his possession. Insp Mudzilawati Abdul Rahman prosecuted, while the accused did not have legal representation.
