TYT receives courtesy call from Judicial Appointments Commission

KUCHING: Sarawak Governor Tun Pehin Sri Dr Wan Junaidi Tuanku Jaafar and wife Toh Puan Fauziah Mohd Sanusi received a courtesy call yesterday from members of the Judicial Appointments Commission (SPK) at Astana here.

Chief Justice of Sabah and Sarawak Tan Sri Dato Abdul Rahman Sebli led the delegation,

which was the first from SPK since Wan Junaidi was appointed Yang di-Pertua Negeri earlier this year.

The Astana in a press release said SPK's visit was to update the governor on the administrative mechanism for the appointment of judicial commissioner in Sabah and Sarawak, which requires the consent of the governors of the two states as per the Malaysia

Agreement 1963.
