

Driver pleads guilty to causing collision, fined RM1,800

SIBU: A female driver was fined RM1,800 in default two months' jail by the Magistrates' Court here yesterday after she pleaded guilty to a traffic offence.

Magistrate Punitha Sivaraji also ordered the accused, Josephine Wong Chii Hie, to pay prosecution costs amounting to RM1,500 in default two months' jail.

Wong was charged under Section 119(2) of the Road Transport Act 1987, read together with Section 128(1) of the same Act.

The section carries a maximum fine of RM2,000 or a jail term not exceeding six months upon conviction.

Wong failed to give way to a motorcycle that was travelling straight along Jalan Tong Sang here at about 2pm on Oct 19, 2020, resulting in a collision that left the rider with injuries.
